## 2015 Future Leaders Award Criteria

Prize donated by LMA

*The trophy was first awarded in 1993 and is dedicated to Vince Aisthorpe.*

The purpose of the Future Leaders Award award is to provide incentive and recognition to young professionals who are both currently working in and wish to continue their career path within the Supply Chain, Logistics and Transport Industry. This is a wonderful opportunity to showcase young professionals within our great industry. Finalists will be interviewed by a panel of judges the week leading up to the awards.

### Criteria:

- Describe your/or the nominee's career path to date.
- What development activities have you/or the nominee's undertaken since leaving school?
- What will your/or the nominee's future within the SCL industry look like?
- Nominees must reside and work in Australia and be 30 years and under to be eligible for this award.

### Prize:

**The winner of the 2015 Future Leaders Award will be awarded an enrolment into the Leadership Management Australia's 'The Performance Edge' 10 week development program valued at \$5000. The program assists participants to improve their personal performance and productivity as well as that of their team. The prize includes consultation in the workplace, assistance in the development of some professional goals, all course material, attendance at 10 interactive workshops, facilitation and course coaching and access to LMA's unique on-line feedback system.**

1. Submissions must indicate the award for which the entry is nominated.
2. Where a nomination is for a project, the nomination must be for demonstrable excellence for project/task completion within the 12 month period preceding the 25th of September 2015, not proposals or partly implemented projects.
3. All nominations for awards must be submitted in Microsoft Word format and all supporting material including Powerpoints, references and images emailed to [ascla@sclaa.com.au](mailto:ascla@sclaa.com.au)
4. Assessment of the submissions will consider:
  - Relevance and compliance to the award criteria.
  - Achievements of the submission with regard to the attainment of stated objectives.
  - Innovation and/or unique concepts.
  - Where more than one organisation is involved in the submission, achievements of total Supply Chain effectiveness.
  - Sustainability of the submission subject.
  - Quality assurance systems, and key performance indicators.
  - Organisation/customer specific attributes.
  - Creativeness and professionalism.
5. **The written submission is to be NO MORE than 2000 words.** The document can ONLY be submitted in a word document. All supporting images must be individually emailed as 300 dpi jpegs and NOT embedded in the word document. Please do not send pdf submissions as they will not be accepted.
6. All applications MUST have the submission form attached from page 2 of this document.

4. Supporting high quality photographs/CD/video or other visual material.
5. Quantification of the contribution of the nomination – financial, service, quality, value-added etc.
6. Any other relevant information that best represents the achievement/s of the nominee.
